Safari at the Amboseli Park in Kenya

It is possible to provide an extension of the tented safari to admire the landscape and animals of the **Amboseli National Park** that hosts numerous elephants with very long tusks, perhaps the most beautiful specimens of the entire African continent.

[Mount Kilimanjaro](#) dominates the park and, especially at sunrise and sunset, it shows itself in all its grandeur as a backdrop for the safari.

During the safari you can admire numerous animal species such as lions, hyenas, cheetahs, elephants, buffaloes, wildebeests, zebras, baboons, ostriches and numerous species of antelopes.



Useful info

In Kenya the climate is tropical with **two rainy seasons**: the heavy rainy season in the months from March to May and the small rainy season in the months from November to mid-December; the dry season is in the months from June to October.

The coast has a wetter climate with higher temperatures, while the hinterland plateau has milder temperatures and a drier climate.

To visit the country, **malaria prophylaxis is recommended**, there are no mandatory vaccinations.

In your suitcase cannot miss: the camera, binoculars, comfortable clothing in neutral colors, a fleece for the evening, sunscreen with a high protection factor and sunglasses.
